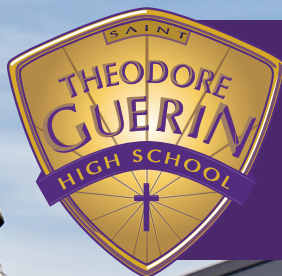

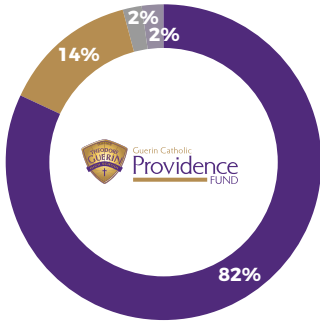

Tuition Assistance **82%**

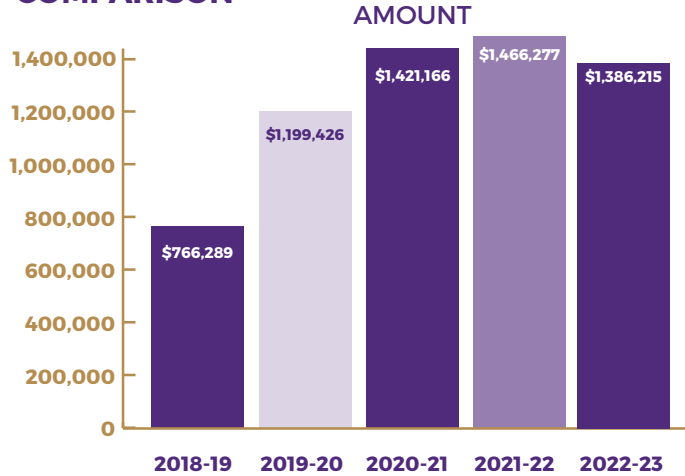
