GUERIN CATHOLIC OPENS ITS DOORS FOR INAUGURAL SCHOOL YEAR ***Students, administrators prepared to begin school year on Monday, Aug. 16***

NOBLESVILLE — Blessed Theodore Guerin High School, the first Catholic high school built in Indiana in 30 years, will open its doors for its inaugural school year on Monday, Aug. 16 at 7:30 a.m. Melanie Ajdaharian, who was the first student to enroll at Guerin Catholic, along with her parents, were invited to open the doors to the school's first arriving students that day. Faculty, staff and administrators will also be present to welcome all of the students at the school's main door as they enter in to begin the new school year.

"We are starting a new ministry in Hamilton County for our youth," said principal Keith Marsh. "I envisioned this day from the first day I accepted the position and can remember walking the site trying to imagine what the high school would look like when it was completed — today it is a reality. I think this is a great opportunity for our students, faculty, staff and community. We are all very blessed."

Included in the first day's itinerary is a 9:20 a.m. mass. Parents and community members are invited, however seating may be limited.

Guerin Catholic High School currently has 100 students enrolled for the 2004-05 school year, including 26 sophomores and 74 freshmen.
