GREG SCHELLHASE NAMED GUERIN CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC DIRECTOR ***University High School A.D. hired lead Golden Eagles' athletic department***

NOBLESVILLE, IND. — Officials from St. Theodore Guerin High School have announced that Greg Schellhase has been named the school's Athletic Director, effective July 1. Schellhase has served as University High School's Director of Athletics since the school's inception in 2000. He is replacing Eric Anderson, who resigned in April as the school's inaugural Athletic Director.

"I am really looking forward to the opportunity at Guerin Catholic," said Schellhase. "It is a wonderful school that is headed in a very positive direction and I am very enthusiastic to be a part of the further growth and development of both the school and athletic program. I believe Guerin Catholic has a very bright future ahead, and I am excited to be the lead in taking the athletic program to the next level."

At University High School, Schellhase not only served as the school's Director of Athletics, but was also the head of the Physical Education Department, head boys' basketball coach and head baseball coach. As Director of Athletics, his responsibilities included hiring, supervising, leading and evaluating the coaches. He was in charge of planning and implementing the budget for the athletic programs and coordinated the scheduling of all athletic facilities and officials for events.

"I am thrilled to have the opportunity to work with Greg Schellhase," said Rick Wagner, who was recently named the school's principal. "I have known Greg for a number of years and know him to be a fine administrator and a quality person. He is a great fit for Guerin Catholic."

At University High School, Schellhase was instrumental in the athletic department fundraising by starting the athletic booster club that helped support the entire athletic program. He also helped generate funds to build tennis courts for the school in 2004. As head boys' basketball coach at University, Schellhase led the team to the Christian/Independent State Championship in 2005 and then a sectional championship in 2006.

Schellhase has worked in Catholic education throughout his entire career. Prior to arriving at University High School, he served as a volunteer assistant athletic director, coach and teacher at Bishop Chatard High School from 1997-2001. He also worked at Our Lady of Lourdes School for three years as the head of the Physical Education Department and Assistant Athletic Director and was a coach and athletic department intern at Lafayette Central Catholic High School from 1994-97.

Schellhase received a Bachelor of Science degree from Purdue University, and then went on to obtain his Master's Degree in Sports Management and Administration from Indiana State University. He is a member of the Society for the Study of Legal Aspects of Sport and Physical Activity (SSLASPA), the National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association (NIAAA), the Indiana Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association (IIAAA), the National Association for Sport and Physical Education, the Indiana Basketball Coaches Association and the Indiana Independent Schools Athletic Directors Association (IISAA).

A member of St. Alphonsus parish, Schellhase and his wife Ellen reside in Zionsville with their two children Claire (3) and Owen (1).

Guerin Catholic High School, a school of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana, is entering its second year in varsity competition fielding 16 varsity teams including football, volleyball, cross country, girls' soccer, boys' soccer, girls' tennis, boys' tennis, girls' basketball, boys' basketball, wrestling, girls' golf, boys' golf, baseball, softball, boys' lacrosse and track and field.
