I would like to introduce to you the Guerin Catholic Parent Guild. This is our version of a Parents' Association or a PTO. Our main focus is to support our students, faculty, staff and community through various activities. We have many different committees that serve a wide variety of purposes. Some of these require help a few times a month and others need volunteers only one time per year. The time commitment is entirely up to each individual.

For example, we **support our students** by helping them put on the Homecoming Dance and the Prom. And each day after school ends, we sell snacks and drinks at the Golden Eagle Snack Stand if they need something to eat before going to their after school activities or athletic practice.

We **support our Faculty and Staff** by providing Tuesday Treats every week as well as dinners for them on Progress Report nights. We help the Admissions department with the Open House and the Incoming Freshman Ice Cream Social.

We **support our community** by hosting the Used Book and Uniform Sale during the summer.
