



WHY GUERIN CATHOLIC?

KAIROS

FAITH is the cornerstone at Guerin Catholic. Our students attend Mass at least once per week with four additional opportunities during the week. Kairos is our faith and study period that students participate in daily. Freshmen Kairos is comprised of freshmen only, giving them a chance to “learn the ropes” of Guerin Catholic together and build strong “Kairos bonds.”

Beginning sophomore year, Kairos is comprised of female- or male-only sophomore, junior and senior students. This gives students a chance to see leadership at all age levels and allows senior students to serve as mentors to their younger counterparts. Students stay with the same Kairos leader (a faculty member) from sophomore through senior year, building a mentorship between teacher and student that is long lasting.

St. Theodore (Anne-Therese) Guerin

Saint Mother Theodore Guerin, patroness of Guerin Catholic High School, lived in the 1800s, but she continues to be a woman who inspires people today with her faith, love, and courage.

After an extraordinary journey from France, Saint Mother Theodore arrived in the dense forest of Saint Mary-of-the-Woods (Terre Haute, IN) in 1840 where she started a novitiate for the Sisters of Providence and a school for girls.

On October 15, 2006, Mother Theodore was canonized into sainthood. Canonization is the formal declaration by the Church that a Christian whose life was an outstanding witness to Christian virtue is now in heaven and interceding for us. With canonization, Mother Theodore received the title “saint” and was approved to be venerated by the worldwide Church. As the patroness of Saint Theodore Guerin High School and the first “Hoosier” to be declared a saint, her canonization is a historic event for the school and entire community.

Saint Theodore Guerin’s feast day is celebrated October 3.
