Where Are They Now? Checking in with our Alums Lauren Bowers



Lauren Bowers was no stranger to the Guerin Catholic Fine Arts Department during her time at Guerin Catholic. Throughout her four years she participated in many plays, GoldenVoice, Sounds of Providence, and many musicals. Her most notable Guerin Catholic roles were Rube in Dames at Sea in 2009 and the Sour Kangaroo in Seussical during her senior year in 2010. After graduating from Guerin Catholic, she attended Hanover College where she participated in sacred choral groups, small jazz ensembles, and voice lessons. Though she was not involved in music theater, she still made sure to keep music as one of her passions while attending the college. She graduated from Hanover in 2014. We checked in with Lauren to see her life with music and fine arts post her higher education:

Class of 2010

"After graduating in 2014, I moved back home and started working at Angie's List in downtown Indianapolis. During those first few months at my new job in my post-grad life, I felt a void; my days were monotonous and consisted of a repetitive schedule of wake up, work, dinner, sleep – and repeat. It was around that time that Willie Wood reached out to me to let me know that he was directing a musical at a local community theater called Footlite Musicals. Willie directed the production of *Dames at Sea* that I starred in my senior year at Guerin, and he has been an influential person in my musical theater experiences. He let me know that he was directing the holiday classic, *White Christmas*. I chose to audition for the show because I truly desired to have

music in my life again and to find a community of people to spend time and grow with. I was cast in a small part in *White Christmas*, but I

couldn't have been more grateful. That small part changed my life; it gave me the creative outlet that I needed to balance my daytime desk job. My involvement in White Christmas inspired me to continue my pursuit of theater at Footlite and I've since performed in two more shows: Hairspray (Spring 2015) and Nice Work If You Can Get It (Fall 2015). Nice Work was a special show for me, as the production was an Indianapolis premiere – the show is a jukebox musical



written around well-known songs by George and Ira Gershwin. I played the leading female role and it was a incredible experience. My experiences at Footlite thus far have taught me so much about musical theater, introduced me to some truly wonderful people, and expanded my day-to-day life beyond a typical 9-to-5 schedule. Many thanks to the Footlite community for welcoming me back to musical theater, to Mr. Willie Wood for introducing me to Footlite, and to Guerin Catholic for sparking my passion of performing."
