Don't take for granted the old family traditions and perhaps start a new one!

- 1. **Share Christmas cheer** to an unknown neighbor with baked goods and a Christmas carol.
- 2. **Read the nativity narrative** from the Gospel of Matthew around the Christmas tree together.
- 3. "Get Cookin"—Have the entire family cook a special themed meal together. Why not try the Italian tradition of the Feast of the Seven Fishes?
- 4. Read a short story out loud together—
 Try "The Gift of the Magi" by O. Henry or "The Story of the Other Wise Man" by Henry van Dyke.
- 5. **Donate the shirt off your back**—Have each family member fill a bag of their own clothes or other items to donate to the St. Vincent de Paul store.
- 6. **Stay up late**—Put out luminaries to welcome the Christ child and attend Midnight Mass.
- 7. "Take Back Your Imagination Day"—
 All family members fast from computers and phones the entire day! Enjoy each other's company by playing a new card game such as Euchre or by having a gingerbread house competition!
