Uniforms All Guerin Catholic uniforms, including Mass Day and Kinesiology uniforms, must be purchased through Land's End. Cost varies. **www.landsend.com/uniforms** (*Preferred School Code 900150715*)

Textbooks Costs vary depending on course selection. You may purchase books used from any online vendor. Utilizing Guerin Catholic's online vendor, **MBS Direct**, will give you the benefit of a higher book buy-back rate for re-adopted editions. Estimate of average cost is between \$200 and \$750 per student.

Lunch Guerin Catholic offers lunch for purchase in the cafeteria. Lunches purchased are approximately \$4 to \$5 per day, depending on items purchased. Guerin Catholic does not participate in the National School Lunch Program.

MacBooks Guerin Catholic is a one-to-one MacBook School. Prior to the start of each school year, the School will identify the specific requirements of the MacBook that are necessary. Each student is required to have a MacBook that fits those requirements. Cost of a new MacBook that meets minimum specifications is estimated to start around \$800.

Semi-Annual, Quarterly, and Monthly Payment Plan due dates are either the 5th or the 20th of the month, depending on the customer's selection upon activation of the agreement.

Graduating Seniors Accounts for graduating seniors must be paid in full by April 30, 2020, or the student will not receive a diploma and may also risk losing the privilege of being able to "walk" at the graduation ceremony.

Delinquent Accounts The school policy states: To encourage parents and guardians to keep their student's accounts current, students with delinquent accounts will not have online access to student report cards, and both parent and student may be blocked from access to Canvas until all delinquent accounts are corrected.

Further, the School will not forward official transcripts of credits to a requesting secondary school or college for any student with unpaid financial obligations which includes not only tuition, but fees and other charges made with the School. (This applies to both transferring and graduating students.)

ATHLETIC FEES All athletic registrations are completed online. Athletic fees will be added to the family's FACTS payment plan. Additional costs may be incurred for practice packs.
