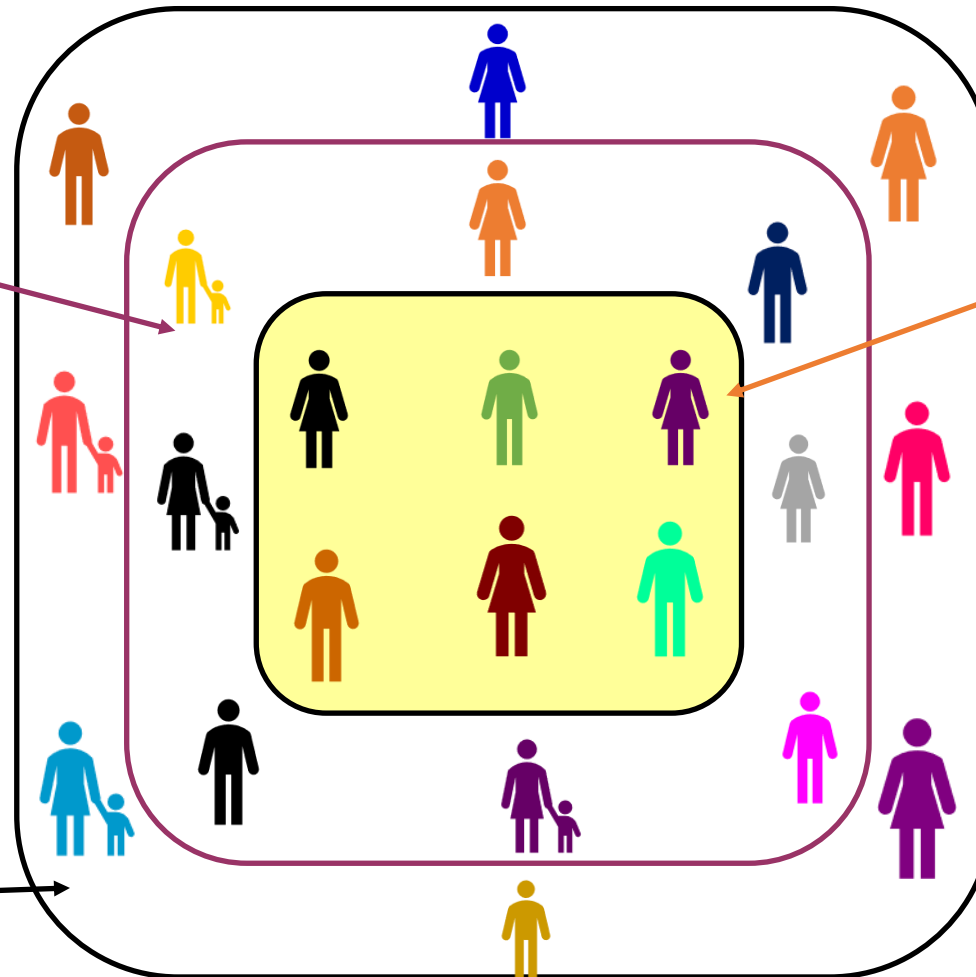


Example Of COVID Exposure

These people have direct or close contact with someone who is positive for COVID-19 or greater than 6 feet and longer than 15 minutes with someone who is COVID-19 positive or has symptoms. (Example, pool party, family gatherings or large events with close contact)

These people are now quarantine for 14 days after the last exposures.

These people are low risk, exposure, they need to watch for symptoms for 14 days. This group can continue to work and attend school.



These people have tested positive for COVID-19 OR are waiting on COVID-19 test results OR have symptoms of COVID-19.

They are now in Isolation.

At least 10 days have passed *since symptoms first appeared* and

At least 24 hours have passed *since last fever* without the use of fever-reducing medications and

Symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath) have improved .
