

WE WANT YOU TO FEEL SAFE AT CAMP PURPLE.

We are committed to providing high levels of safety and disinfection during the COVID-19 pandemic while monitoring guidelines from the Indiana State Deptartment of Health and the CDC. Although we cannot create a completely sterile environment, Guerin Catholic is prepared so that all who visit will remain as safe as possible.

All Camp Purple campers need to:

- Bring and wear a mask to wear
- Allow screening for elevated temperature via an electronic non-contact thermometer prior to each visit
- Wash hands frequently and for 20 seconds while at camp and/or utilize hand sanitizer when soap and water aren't available.
- Allow social distance of at least six feet from others.*
- Not attend camp if ill.
- Complete a health assessment before attending camp (health assessment form will need to be filled out for each camp attending)
- Notify us of confirmed cases or close contact of COVID-19 on our 24/7 COVID-19 hotline at 317.660.0499.

*For athletic camps, we can't ensure distancing, but we do have measures in place to ensure minimal close contacts. For example: assigned small groups that participants stay in throughout the week or consistent partnerships, intentional spacing between participants when waiting to take a turn in a drill, assigned socially distant areas for group talks or water breaks, and utilizing rotations to ensure minimal interactions between groups.
