

RULES OF THE 2021 GUERIN CATHOLIC TRIVIA NIGHT

- Each team will consist of 10 players (or less).
- There will be 8 rounds with 10 questions per round, plus a bonus question.
- Opening prayer and review of the rules will begin at **6:45 PM**.
- The first round will begin **PROMPTLY** at **7:00 PM**. Pizza will be served after Round 5 during the 20 minute Intermission.
- **CELL PHONE USAGE and TEXTING are NOT PERMITTED in the GYM**. If you need to make or receive a phone call/text, you must do so in the hallway. Please note that you will not be permitted to return to your table until the end of competition for that round. If any of our volunteers see you using your phone in the gym your **TEAM will lose ALL points for THAT round. No exceptions!**
- Please refrain from moving around the room or using the restroom during rounds. Your servers are happy to refill your drinks! Please remember that if you leave the room to use the restroom you cannot return until the completion of that round.
- **A BONUS QUESTION WILL BE ASKED AT THE END OF EACH ROUND**. Each team can **BID** for the **CLUE** to this question. Bidding will last no more than 2 minutes. Highest bidder wins the **CLUE**. The **CLUE** will be delivered to the team/table in

exchange for payment of the CLUE. **CREDIT CARDS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR PAYMENT OF CLUES!**

- For 3 of the 8 rounds, an EXPERT will be auctioned prior to the start of the round. Bidding will last no more than 2 minutes. The highest bidder wins. The expert will sit with the winning team/table for the entire round, including the BONUS question. **CREDIT CARDS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR PAYMENT OF AN EXPERT!**
- A Live Auction will be held prior to Round 4 and Round 6.
- Each correct answer is worth 1 point. Each correct answer to the BONUS QUESTION is worth 5 points.
- If there is a TIE at the end of the evening, estimates of your table's final score (submitted during Round 1) will be used to determine the Champion by calculating the difference between your estimate and the actual score for your table.
- All answers MUST BE COMPLETE AND WRITTEN LEGIBLY.

("Indianapolis Indians"- not "Indians") ("Pope Pius XII"-not "Pope Pius")

- **NO CHALLENGES** are allowed. The game judges are the ultimate authority. Our questions come from credible sources.
- An "Expert" is allowed to participate at a Trivia Night table for the evening. However, he/she will only be able to assist the table who bid the highest for the expert and cannot return to their own table until the beginning of the next round.

- **It is a fun, full evening!** Please allow our MC, Mr. Joe Lustig, to begin each round on time. The questions will be on display at the front of the room AND we will have roaming volunteers to help if you did not see the question or hear Mr. Lustig. This is an effort to keep the evening moving and make it fun for all participants! It is the responsibility of each team to listen to the questions.
- **Mulligans (a sticker) are available at the RAFFLE TABLE or from a volunteer before each round.** The cost for a MULLIGAN is \$20 each. Payments can be made by cash, check and CREDIT CARDS. When you choose to use a MULLIGAN, you must designate on the answer sheet which question it will be used for by placing the sticker on that specific answer line. That answer will automatically be marked correct. Mulligan sales end at the beginning of Round 7.
- **Your team is allowed to use 2 MULLIGANS per round. You may NOT use a MULLIGAN for the BONUS Question.**
- **50/50 Raffle Tickets** are \$10 each. You can purchase tickets from the RAFFLE TABLE or a committee volunteer. Payments must be made by cash, check or DEBIT CARD. Sales end at the beginning of Round 9. The winners will be drawn at the end of the evening.
- **Table Raffle Prizes:** We are offering **NEW** and exciting Table Raffles this year for 2021. The cost of a raffle ticket is \$5 each. You may purchase a raffle ticket from the RAFFLE TABLE or a committee volunteer. Payments must be made by cash, check or DEBIT CARD. Raffle sales end at the beginning of Round 7.

- **What's in your Bottle Raffle** : Another **NEW** and exciting raffle for this year! The cost of the raffle ticket is \$10. We will be pulling 5 raffle tickets for each round of "What's in your bottle" and you will open it to reveal a cash prize! Only one cash prize per round. Payments must be made by cash, check or DEBIT CARD
- Beer, wine, soft drinks and water will be provided. **NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOL IS PERMITTED PER OUR INDIANA LIQUOR LICENSE.** Last call will be announced before Round 6 with service ending at the beginning of Round 7.
- **PLEASE REMEMBER TO DRINK RESPONSIBLY.** Consider choosing a designated driver for your team! If you feel you have overindulged and need a ride, please do not hesitate to ask one of the committee volunteers for assistance. A list of taxi services that serve northern Hamilton County will be located in your table folders for the evening. You may also use Uber or some other ride service.
- This a non-refundable event.

TABLE DECORATIONS/THEMES

- Guests may coordinate with their table to create a theme for the evening attire and table decorations! ***A prize will be given for the most creative theme!***
- You may also "come as you are" but are encouraged to wear your Guerin Catholic attire to show your Golden Eagle pride!

Please adhere to these guidelines for the tables:

- No centerpieces or structures over 3 feet high.
- NO FIRE!!! (i.e., candles, torches, etc.)
- Food is permitted at the tables to share – please bring all necessary serving pieces (napkins, plates, utensils, etc.)
- No large coolers please.
