THE BISHOP WILLIAM L. HIGI LEADERSHIP AWARDS

The Bishop William L. Higi Leadership Award is presented annually to individuals who have exemplified their faith by taking risks and being a catalyst for transformational change in their community.

Inaugural awardees, in concert with Bishop Higi, had a vision of providing a Catholic high school education to those in the deanery and Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana. In the face of ruthless opposition and constant setbacks, they put their faith ahead of their fears and, for the first time in sixty years, helped open a new Catholic high school in Indiana.

As of today, more than 18 years after Guerin Catholic opened her doors, the school has been recognized consistently as one of the top Catholic high schools in the nation.

TERENCE P. WEISS



One of the first true leaders for Guerin Catholic, Terry was instrumental in ensuring the school had the necessary funding for construction and carried the finance committee through the completion of the physical building and ultimately the opening and growth of the student body.

Fundraising for Guerin Catholic came to a standstill due to the attacks on September 11, 2001 and the meltdown of the technology industry in 2002. But Terry's leadership and dedication to the concept of a Catholic high school in Hamilton County was instrumental in maneuvering through the obstacles—eventually breaking ground for the school in 2002. He spearheaded countless early morning meetings, and the finance committee leaned on his industry knowledge and expertise in order to meet and exceed their goals.

"Terry was always very respectful of our time," explained Mike Mewborn who sat on the finance committee with Weiss. "Each meeting would begin promptly at 6:30 a.m. There was one meeting, however, that Terry showed up about 20 minutes late, which was very out of character for him. We asked if everything was okay, and he proceeded to apologize for being late and explained that his new home had burned to the ground overnight! That summarizes his dedication to Guerin Catholic and her mission!"

There was no task too daunting for Terry during the many challenges in the early years of Guerin Catholic. His solution-oriented approach provided a beacon of hope and inspiration for the others on the committee and helped solidify Guerin Catholic's survival and ultimate success. He laid the groundwork for the finance committee and continues to be available whenever called upon by the administration.

A pillar of leadership from the beginning, Terry will always be remembered as one of the founding members of Guerin Catholic High School.

Terry received his undergraduate degree in Accounting and his Master's in Business Administration with a Major in Finance and concentration in Corporate Finance and Investments from Indiana University Bloomington. He and his wife Marcia have one son, Chris, and two daughters, Jessica '10 and Emily '13 and are long-time members of St. Elizabeth Seton Parish in Carmel.

Even before Mike began teaching at Guerin Catholic in 2005, he was here from the beginning—as a bass player for *Godspell*, Guerin Catholic's first ever theater production, and as a coach for the Golden Eagle football team.

He was a member of University Theater and was cast in three plays during his four years at Ferris State. He also was a four-year starter as a punter and kicker on the football team. He later went on to earn a second bachelor's degree in English Education with a minor in Speech and Theater from IUPUI. He received his Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from the University of Dayton.

Mike and his wife Alanna have two children, Audrey and Alexis, and are members of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish.

"The idea of a brand-new school with no history, no accolades and no reputation appealed to me. Going to Guerin Catholic was the first big risk of my life. It would either turn out amazing or be one of my biggest regrets¹," says Adriana Pratt Mansour '08.

From the first time she walked through the doors of her new school in 2004, Adriana immersed herself into nearly every aspect of Guerin Catholic, choosing to be involved in fine arts, athletics, clubs and student government. By the time she graduated in 2008, Adriana had participated in nearly every extra-curricular activity that was available, worked diligently to secure an International Baccalaureate Diploma, and was recognized as co-valedictorian of the school's first four-year graduating class.

"She approaches everything she does with passion, humility and faith," notes her dad and long-time School Governing Board member, Mike Pratt. "I am proud to have her as a living testimony to the formation this school provides."

Prior to the school hiring an alumni director, Adriana unofficially served in that capacity being the liaison between alumni and the administration for a number of years. She was called upon multiple times each year to help plan and communicate alumni events, and she answered the call without hesitation. To this day, Adriana is one of Guerin Catholic's greatest ambassadors!

Adriana is still an active member of the Golden Eagle Alumni base and has attended and coordinated homecomings, Masses, reunions and other special events regularly since graduating. ST. THEODORE GUERIN STATUE

This year's Fund-a-Need will go toward a bronze statue of St. Theodore Guerin to be placed in the Dr. John Bates Outdoor Courtyard which links the two academic wings at Guerin Catholic. The statue will be an exact replica of the statue at the school founded by Mother Guerin, St. Mary-of-the-Woods College in Terre Haute, Indiana.

Guerin Catholic has commissioned Teresa Clark as the artist of the statue. Clark is the creator of the original mold used for the limestone carving of Mother Theodore at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C., and the bronze statues at St. Mary of the Woods, the Sisters of Providence

Mother House in Northwestern France, and the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

Clark considered herself a non-religious person before beginning the project but converted to Catholicism during her work on the original statue in 2006, stating, "I think she's created me as much as I've created her," when referencing St. Theodore Guerin. "There were some late nights that I swear she was talking!" Clark is now a Providence Associate.

Guerin Catholic hopes to raise \$50,000 for the 6-foot bronze statue.
