**Learning Support** Guerin Catholic's Learning Support Program provides extensive individual support for students as they achieve their goals. Through continued development of a student's skills, they work toward self-advocacy and independent learning. With the help of the student, parent, and the Learning Support Team, an academic plan is developed for each student to ensure growth and success in the classroom.

### SCHOLARSHIP GRANTING ORGANIZATION (SGO)



Guerin Catholic continues to partner with the **Institute for Quality Education (IQE)** as our

official Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO). An SGO is a state-designated 501(c)(3) that provides financial needs-based scholarships to students enrolled in non-public schools.

By giving a gift through IQE and designating it to Guerin Catholic, you will be providing needs-based scholarships to eligible incoming and current GC students.

As of July 1, 2021, students of Hoosier families whose household income is 300% or less of the amount required for the individual to qualify for the federal free and reduced lunch program now to meet eligibility requirements to receive Choice Scholarship and SGO awards for the 2021-22 school year to help cover the cost of private school tuition.

This is **great** news for our Guerin Catholic families who qualify. Thanks to a record number of SGO donors last year, we were able to award 75 SGO scholarships—some of which served as a pathway for families to be awarded a Choice Scholarship toward Guerin Catholic tuition for the next year.
