Year-Long Ensembles

Students in the Guerin Catholic Music Department often start with one ensemble but audition for more as they grow as a musician! Our directors are available to mentor students to find the right balance for their ability and time availability. Please know that it is very possible to be in multiple ensembles if you're disciplined with your schedule and you communicate well!

It is also important to understand the credit that each course offers. For example, a student who is enrolled in String Orchestra for four years, then joins Ambrose their sophomore through senior year would end up with 15 credits just from these two music classes! Yes - that's an entire extra year of Fine Arts credits compared to a peer that did not audition for an ensemble at Guerin Catholic!

Zero-Period Ensembles

All Zero Period Ensembles meet Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 7:35-8:25 AM. Like other classes at Guerin Catholic, students enrolled in these courses receive one credit per trimester.

String Orchestra

String Orchestra is an auditioned, string ensemble that plays regularly throughout the year at Guerin Catholic Masses, three department concerts, and other various community events. Members of this ensemble should have prior experience on violin, viola, cello, or string bass. This class meets during zero period on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday mornings.

Wind Symphony

Wind Symphony is an auditioned band ensemble that plays the most advanced literature for bands performing in Group I at the ISSMA Concert Band State Qualifying contest. Students perform regularly throughout the year at Guerin Catholic Masses, three departmental concerts, and other various community events. This class provides students with a balanced, comprehensive study of music through the concert band, which develops skills in the psychomotor, cognitive, and affective domains. This performance ensemble is open to students in grades 9-12 who play woodwind, brass, bass guitar/string bass, or percussion instruments. The primary goal of this course is to teach students authentic, performance-based musical skills. The curriculum also includes but is not limited to: pep band performances throughout the fall football season, concerts throughout the academic year, ISSMA organized performances such as ISSMA State Qualification Contest, and participation in the ISSMA solo and ensemble, performances at community related events as well as school related events such as parades, pep sessions and commencement ceremonies. Away/overnight trips are possible. The Wind Symphony includes a pep band requirement unless a student has a valid conflict with the pep band season, such as a GCHS fall sport. Students that are unable to participate in the pep band due to a valid conflict are still eligible for this course, but are excused from pep band commitments.

Sounds of Providence

Sounds of Providence is a select, auditioned chamber choir that sings regularly at Guerin Catholic Masses, performs at concerts including department concerts, and sings frequently throughout the year for other various school and community events. Auditions are held in May for the following year. Members of Sounds of Providence are in the Music Kairos, and earn 1 credit per trimester for involvement in this choir. This class meets during zero period on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday mornings.

Kairos Ensembles

These ensembles normally meet two times per week during Kairos from 11:10 - 11:40. They are credit-bearing courses but because of the unique scheduling, students receive one credit per year for each Kairos Ensemble in which they are enrolled. For example, a student involved in GoldenVoice and St. Theodora's Jazz Orchestra would earn two credits over the course of a school year in these ensembles.

GoldenVoice

GoldenVoice is an auditioned, mixed-voice advanced concert choir that sings regularly at Guerin Catholic Masses, performs at three department concerts, and sings throughout the year for other various events. Auditions are held in May for the following school year. GoldenVoice is open to sophomore through senior boys and sophomore through senior girls. Members of GoldenVoice are in the Music Kairos, and earn 1 credit per year for involvement in this choir.

Cecilia

Cecilia is an auditioned, all-girl concert choir that sings regularly at Guerin Catholic Masses, performs in three department concerts, and sings throughout the year for other various events. Auditions are open throughout the school year by contacting the director. Members of Cecilia are in the Music Kairos, and earn 1 credit per year for involvement in this choir.

Ambrose

Ambrose is an auditioned, all-boy concert choir that sings regularly at Guerin Catholic Masses, performs in three department concerts, and sings throughout the year for other various events. Auditions are open throughout the school year by contacting the director. Members of Ambrose are in the Music Kairos, and earn 1 credit per year for involvement in this choir.

St. Theodora's Jazz Orchestra

A traditional "big band" and is open to students who play saxophone, trumpet, trombone, piano, bass, drums and guitar who have adequately developed technique on their instrument and are interested in performing jazz and popular music. The classes dig into many genres including swing, rock, funk, and latin styles. Literature for this ensemble will be selected from the standard "big band" and contemporary repertoire. Intervals, chord structure, chord progressions and improvisation will be studied. Students taking this course develop musicianship and specific performance skills through group and individual settings for the study and performance of the varied styles of instrumental jazz. The instruction includes the study of the history, formative, and

stylistic elements of jazz. Students develop their creative skills through: (1) improvisation, (2) composition, (3) arranging, (4) performing, (5) listening, and (6) analyzing. Students are provided with opportunities to experience live performances by professionals during and outside of the school day. A limited amount of time outside of the school day may be scheduled for dress rehearsals and performances. In addition, a limited number of public performances may serve as a culmination of daily rehearsal and music goals. Students must participate in performance opportunities, outside of the school day, that support and extend the learning in the classroom. This group participates in ISSMA Jazz Festival each spring. Jazz is a uniquely American art form, and GCHS Jazz students seek to preserve and perform it at its highest level!

All members of director-run ensembles are expected to participate in leading music at Mass. This is our greatest honor and responsibility as a department and should be treated as such.

Praise & Worship Club

The Guerin Catholic Praise and Worship Group is a club made up of all types of students and teachers. The goal of this club is to help people encounter the Lord through prayer, praise, and worship. They meet Wednesday mornings at 7:45 in the St. Joseph Chapel to adore Jesus Christ through their gift of song.

Auditions

The Music Department is a welcoming environment that hopes many students join our program every year! To ensure that students are put in the ensemble that best matches their level of knowledge and ability, students are expected to audition for all GC year-long ensembles. While we expect the highest level of commitment from those in our ensembles, we have an ensemble that fits any level of musical ability!

Auditions are held each spring to join our ensembles. If you are interested in joining during the school year, please reach out to the director of the ensemble you are interested in joining to see if membership is possible. Based on available spots in the ensemble, students are sometimes able to audition during the first two weeks of each trimester.

Expectations vary between ensembles on whether students are expected to re-audition for their spot in an ensemble. Expectations for re-auditioning annually explained below:

Rehearsal

Rehearsal Procedures and Policies

Rehearsal procedures will be explained by each director; however, there are several expectations that are consistent throughout the department.

1. Students are expected to arrive on time and prepared for each rehearsal.
2. All participants in the rehearsal will treat each other with respect.
3. Because rehearsal time is limited, interruptions should be kept to a minimum. It is preferred that questions not directly related to the rehearsal's content should be asked at the conclusion of the rehearsal.
4. When conflicts arise, we will treat one another with Christian charity.

During full-department rehearsals, it is crucial that students come prepared and are on their best behavior. It is a unique strength of the Guerin Catholic Music Department that we are able to have so many full-department projects to work on as one full ensemble.

Rehearsal Schedules

The commitment of each student is key to the success of the entire ensemble. Please make sure you understand your schedule and communicate questions when you have them!

Kairos rehearsals are dependent on our GC school calendar and change often.
Always consult our Music Department Google Calendar for an up-to-date schedule.

Zero Period rehearsals start promptly at 7:35 a.m. Kairos rehearsals start promptly at 11:10 a.m. Students who are not in their assigned place, fully prepared at that time will be considered tardy to rehearsal. At 4 absences in one trimester, communication will be sent to families. At 6 absences in one trimester, a meeting will be set with the Assistant Principal of Student Services to put a plan in place to help the student develop needed skills to arrive on time and prepared for rehearsal.

Music Kairos

All members of the Music Department will be placed into a Music Kairos. If a student decides to leave an ensemble during the school year, they will be moved out of their Music Kairos into another Guerin Catholic Kairos at the end of the school year.

Grading

Every ensemble at Guerin Catholic (except Golden Eagle Drumline) is a class and should be treated as such. Participation makes up the largest portion of your grade. You should be at rehearsal prepared and on time. Failure to do so will result in the lowering of your grade.

Concerts are mandatory for all members of ensembles. Dates for concerts are given at the beginning of the school year. Please put them on your calendar as soon as you receive them.

If you anticipate a conflict with rehearsals or performances, please communicate it as soon as possible using the Absence Request Form.

Attendance, Conflicts, and Communication

Conflicts will arise, and communication is key! Please reach out to your director as soon as you are made aware of a conflict with rehearsal or any performance. Your director will help you navigate the conflict as much as possible, but cannot help if they are not aware of the conflict!

Every music ensemble (except Golden Eagle Drumline) is a graded class. Missing rehearsals or performances will lower your grade, unless your teacher is made aware of the conflict in advance and has communicated that the absence is excused.

If a student is excused from school, they will also be excused from missed rehearsals or performances that day. If a student is sick or will miss zero period, parents should call the Guerin Catholic Attendance Line (317-660-0404). Please call this attendance line even if the student will attend other classes on that school day.

Missing a Performance

Students are expected to attend all performances. It is a huge disruption to miss even one voice or instrument at a performance! We need you there! Failure to attend a required event (performance, concert, dress rehearsal, festival) without a valid, written excuse via the [Absence Request Form](#) (available from your directors), fully explaining the absence will result in the lowering of the student's grade. Punctuality also impacts grades. Please submit any conflicts in writing to your director as soon as possible to allow your director time to plan for your absence.

Once your conflict has been communicated to your director, you can expect a response within 48 hours that will help you to understand whether the absence is excused or not and how missing a performance could affect your grade.

If you are late to a performance without previous communication, your grade will be lowered. If you miss a performance without previous communication, you will not receive credit and will not be offered the opportunity to make up credit for this assignment.

Kairos Conflicts - What Do I Do?

Any conflict with a Kairos rehearsal will have an effect on your grade in that course. Students should communicate conflicts as soon as possible, and ask their director for guidance when they are unclear on what to do during Kairos. One of the most common requests for missing up rehearsals is asking to make up a test or quiz for another subject. Without approval in advance from your director, missing a rehearsal for any reason - including work for another class - will negatively impact your grade. Guerin Catholic teachers are aware of our rehearsal schedule and will work with students to find another time to make up a quiz or test, if students communicate well and explain their rehearsal schedule. Like all other conflicts, communicate clearly and often to find the best solution.

If you need help managing your calendar, please reach out to your counselor or director for support! It is always better to communicate with these adults that want to help you be a successful member of the Guerin Catholic Music Department.

Athletic Conflicts - What Do I Do?

Communication is key! We want our musicians to be involved in Guerin Catholic athletics. However, we know there are often conflicts with our rehearsals and practices. Look ahead, be prepared, and communicate conflicts with your directors and coaches as early as possible. Even if the table below tells you how to handle your conflict, it is very important that you still communicate the conflict and your proposed solution to both your coach and director! You should always communicate conflicts as early as possible to allow everyone involved time to find the best solution for your situation.

Withdrawal Policy

All ensemble classes are year-long commitments. While we hope that all students are able to maintain involvement in these courses all year, we understand that unusual circumstances do arise, and students need to withdraw from the course. In these instances, the following steps should occur.

1. Speak with your director to see if you can find a short-term solution to your problem that would avoid the need to drop the course.
2. If you have spoken with your director and mutually agreed that dropping the course is the best plan of action, please complete a Music Department withdrawal form. This form will require a reason for dropping, and signatures from the following people: student, parent, director of ensemble, Kairos teacher, and counselor.
3. Submit the form to the Counseling Department.

Add/Drop Window

For all ensembles, there is a grace period within which music courses can be added or dropped without a record of the change on their transcript. **If a student drops a class outside of the Add/Drop Window, your transcript will record that you have withdrawn from the course.** This will have no bearing on your GPA, but will allow your transcript to more accurately reflect the academic choices you have made at Guerin Catholic.

For Zero Period courses, the Add/Drop Window is 10 school days at the beginning of each trimester. (Reminder: Zero Period Courses are Wind Symphony, String Orchestra, and Sounds of Providence)

For Year-Long Kairos Ensembles, the Add/Drop Window is 10 school days at the beginning of the first trimester. There is no Transcript Grace Period in the second or third trimester for Year-Long Kairos Ensembles. (Reminder: Year-Long Kairos Ensembles are GoldenVoice, Cecilia, Ambrose, and St. Theodora's Jazz Orchestra.)

Concert Attire

All students in the Music Department are expected to provide their own concert attire. Concert attire is worn for formal performances such as our three department concerts. The same items are worn for all Music Department ensembles - girls are in dresses, and boys are in tuxes. These are not purchased through the department; each family is responsible for purchasing their own concert attire. Instructions for purchasing your concert attire can be found below.

Concert Attire Closet

Practice Rooms

The Music Department of Guerin Catholic High School is fortunate to have two practice rooms equipped with pianos.

Practice Room Guidelines:

- No food or drink allowed in the practice rooms.
- No equipment may be removed without consent of a music teacher.
- Practice rooms are for practice only, not socializing.
- When using the practice rooms the light must be on.
- Students must be standing or sitting in a chair/bench. Students may not sit or lay on the ground.
- Practice rooms are for music students only unless special permission has been granted from a music faculty member.
- Ensemble rehearsal room pianos may NOT be played by students without permission from a music teacher.

Instrument Locker Room

Each student in Wind Symphony and String Orchestra will be assigned a locker at the beginning of the school year. It is the student's responsibility to keep their locker clean!

If you are in another ensemble or music course that requires you to bring an instrument to school frequently, please ask your teacher about having a locker assigned to you for the trimester or year. Please note: students in Ukulele will not be given an Instrument Locker.

Food should never be consumed in the Instrument Locker Room. No clothing storage is allowed in the lockers, with the exception of items needed for a performance that day.

Cell Phone Policy

Unless given direct permission from your director, there should be no cell phones in rehearsal.

For all ensembles, there is a grace period within which music courses can be added or dropped without a record of the change on their transcript. **If a student drops a class outside of the Add/Drop Window, your transcript will record that you have withdrawn from the course.** This will have no bearing on your GPA, but will allow your transcript to more accurately reflect the academic choices you have made at Guerin Catholic.

For Zero Period courses, the Add/Drop Window is 10 school days at the beginning of each trimester.

For Year-Long Kairos Ensembles, the Add/Drop Window is 10 school days at the beginning of the first trimester. There is no Add/Drop Window in the second or third trimester for Year-Long Kairos Ensembles.
