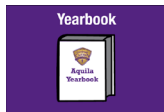
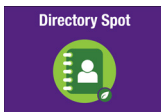
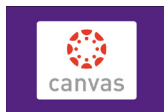

ALGEBRA MASTERY EXAM

Students wishing to take any math class beyond Algebra 1 their freshman year (Geometry or Algebra 2) must take the Algebra Mastery Exam. The exam is being offered on 2 different dates: May 12th at 6 pm and May 16th at 9 am. This exam will take approximately 90 minutes. Registration required.

TEXTBOOK LISTS

It is important that students obtain the correct edition of the textbook; different editions contain different readings, problems or examples. Use the ISBN number when searching for your student's textbooks.

ORDERING TEXTBOOKS

Each family is responsible for purchasing their student's textbooks. Families can decide to buy their books at the beginning of each trimester or for the whole year.

Textbooks can be bought and sold back to the Guerin Catholic Online Bookstore (BNC K-12 Bookstore) or through sites like Amazon, etc. Textbooks and novels for every Guerin Catholic class will be available for purchase in the Guerin Catholic Online Bookstore beginning June 22, 2026 and there is a free shipping period when ordering over \$99 from July 7-12. Parents can also trade, buy or sell textbooks on the Golden Eagle Parent page on Facebook.

Many eText options will be available via our online bookstore. Students are required to have the eText for most World Language and Math courses freshman year.

- Sports registration is done through the Guerin Catholic website, **GuerinCatholic.org**. Please indicate all sports that your child plans to participate in for the 2026-2027 school year (Fall, Winter and Spring seasons). All athletes who wish to participate in ANY summer activity (clinics, leagues, conditioning, help with Camp Purple, etc) must register and submit paperwork (physicals) by June 1, 2026. Athletic fees are billed in the season during which the sport is played and not charged until rosters are final.
- Athletes transferring to Guerin Catholic High School must contact the Guerin Catholic Athletic Department to complete an IHSAA Athletic Transfer prior to competing in an IHSAA contest (this does not include incoming freshmen; only new sophomores, juniors & seniors).

UNIFORMS

Families have two uniform providers to purchase from—SchoolBelles and Lands' End.

Parents can also trade, buy, or sell uniforms on the Golden Eagle Parent page on Facebook. Please order early to avoid stock shortages and delayed deliveries.

DRESS CODE

Regular Uniform

Students wear the following items on normal school days:

- Polo shirt with shield logo (black, white, or purple)
- BOYS: Plain khaki pants with monogrammed "GCHS" on left pocket worn with a belt
- GIRLS: Plain khaki pants with monogrammed "GCHS" on left pocket
- Closed-toe and closed-heel dress shoes or tennis shoes

Optional Outerwear

These items may be worn over the regular uniform on normal school days:

- V-neck sweater with shield
- Black, white, or purple approved Guerin Catholic jacket, ¼ zip, or crewneck sweatshirt
- Polo shirt must be worn underneath

All-School Mass Uniform

On All-School Mass days, the following items must be worn:

- BOYS & GIRLS: White Oxford button-down dress shirt with shield
- BOYS & GIRLS: Outerwear with shield logo if worn during Mass (outerwear with the Golden Eagle logo is not permitted)
- BOYS: Uniform pants with a black or brown belt
- GIRLS: Uniform pants
- BOYS: Must wear a modest tie

Friday Spirit Days/Charity Spirit Days

Every Friday is Spirit Day (unless an All-School Mass falls on a Friday). Solid color jeans (or uniform pants) may be worn but must be clean, neat, without holes or tears, and hemmed. No shorts, joggers, overalls, pajama pants, yoga pants, leggings, or sweats are permitted. Saint Theodore Guerin High School, Guerin Catholic or the Golden Eagle name or logo must be displayed on all shirts or sweatshirts. Hooded sweatshirts are permitted on Spirit Days.

SERVICE HOURS

- All Guerin Catholic Students are required to complete at least **30 hours of service each year**
- Over their four years of high school, students in the Class of 2030 will log at least 60 hours of unpaid service for the school, 30 hours for their parish, and 30 hours in the community.
- Guerin Catholic uses the **MobileServe app** to record and track service hours. Students will set up their MobileServe accounts during the first few weeks of school.
- Service hours completed during the summer count towards the annual requirement for the following school year.
- Students can earn a service cord at commencement by serving 100 hours per year for all four years.

STUDENT LIFE

- Guerin Catholic is proud to offer over 30 clubs serving a wide array of interest
- The goal of clubs is to foster students' exploration in their area(s) of interest, and build social and leadership skills. Particular focus is given to teaching students how to use their gifts and talents to serve others. Under the guidance of club moderators, students can choose from a variety of different clubs, and also have the opportunity to create a new club if there is ample interest.
- In late August, the Office of Campus Ministry & Student Life sponsors a club fair during the school day. Student will have the opportunity to visit with each of the clubs and sign up for those of interest.
- Club fair for the 2026-2027 school year will be **Tuesday, August 25th** during Kairos.

ATTENDANCE LINE: 317-660-0404

- Call the attendance line for any modifications to your students attendance at school (e.g., all day absence, late arrival, and early releases). **EMAILS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
- Advanced notice of attendance modifications is preferred, but calls should be made by 9:00 am on the day of the modification, at latest.
- There is no parent sign in and out. Simply call the attendance line by 9:00 am and a pass will be sent for your student to come to front if you are picking them up for an appointment. Please pull up to front door so student can see you have arrived and they will come out to your car. The same process is followed if you notified school of a late arrival for your student—just drop them at the front door as there is no need to accompany them inside.
- If your student feels ill during school day, please tell them to go to school nurse. The school nurse will assess the situation and contact a parent to decide if the student will be going home.
- Extended Absence Forms are to be completed for three or more days of consecutive absence. Extended Absence forms can be found on the Parent Resource Board or outside the attendance window in the front office. Completed forms should be submitted no later than 24 hours in advance.

SCHOOL LUNCH ACCOUNTS

Cafeteria accounts are managed through **Lunchtime**. Click on the Lunchtime tile on the Parent Resource Board to load money into your student's account. Menus and prices can be found on the Cafeteria tile on the Parent Resource Board.

PARKING PASSES

The registration form for parking passes for student drivers is found on PowerSchool. Once the online registration is complete, your student may pick up a parking pass at orientation or at the front office.
